## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Jefferson County Planning Commission has requested, pursuant to Colo. Rev. Stat. § 22-32-124(1.5)(a), a hearing before the Board of Education of Jefferson County School District No. R-1 regarding the Planning Commission's concerns about the Mountain Phoenix Community School site development in connection with its location at 11398 Ranch Elsie Road in Coal Creek Canyon; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education has reviewed and considered the comments of the Planning Commission regarding the site development plan, dated September 5, 2007, other information provided by the Jefferson County Planning Commission, and the response of Mountain Phoenix Community School to the Planning Commission's comments: and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education held a public hearing on October 11, 2007, in accordance with Colo. Rev. Stat. § 22-32-124(1.5)(a), and considered the presentations of the Jefferson County Planning Commission and Mountain Phoenix Community School, as well as input from District staff and the public;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Jefferson County School District No. R-1, County of Jefferson, State of Colorado, that Mountain Phoenix Community School is prohibited from proceeding with its site development plan in connection with the location of the school at 11398 Ranch Elsie Road in Coal Creek Canyon for the following reasons:

- 1. The Planning Commission recommends that schools be located in designated Community Centers where public infrastructure has been established. This site is outside of a Community Center. The school will be operational within an existing single family dwelling. According to Planning Commission staff, the proposed land use and intensity of the proposed development of the school are not compatible with the surrounding residential mountain environment and will result in a significant increase in traffic in comparison to a household.
- 2. Even though the school, on an interim basis, is providing bottled drinking water and following the protocol set forth in the Bottled Water Advisory issued by the State of Colorado, it has not yet obtained the requisite Public Water Supply Identification Number from the state in order to establish, install, and monitor the non-community drinking water supply.
- 3. Even though the school has worked cooperatively with the Coal Creek Canyon Fire Protection District to develop an interim fire emergency plan and obtained approval from the Fire Marshall to open the school, construction of a fire apparatus access drive has not been completed.
- 4. On-site parking for the faculty and parents is inadequate and the school has indicated that funds are not available for construction of on-site parking within the current budget.
